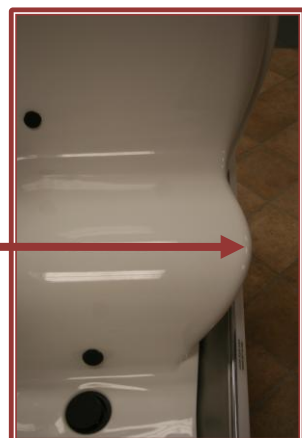


Entrée Bath



The **Entrée** door is self-storing, rotating to full open and closed positions by the push of a button. With the self-storing door, there are no obstructions for entry into the bath. Because of this wider opening, the bather can **transfer into the system without bending their knees. Just “sit and pivot”**.

The unique **“Barrier Free Access”** side-opening feature allows the **Entrée Bath** seat to actually extend over the floor surface. This cantilevered design provides easy access for individuals who are ambulatory, require wheelchair sliding transfer or mechanical lifts. Compare this to other side entry door designs that require a 4” gap between frame and seat, creating a falling sensation for the individual and additional stress for the caregiver.



The deck-mounted high volume anti-scald thermoscopic mixing valve, certified to ASSE 1016-2005, with separate fill and shower flow control is standard on all **MasterCare** bathing systems. Removable control panels for easy servicing.

Simple push button controls, for the **Variable Speed Heated BathAire^(SM)** system and door open/close, can be positioned to allow individuals their independence, for caregiver convenience or both.

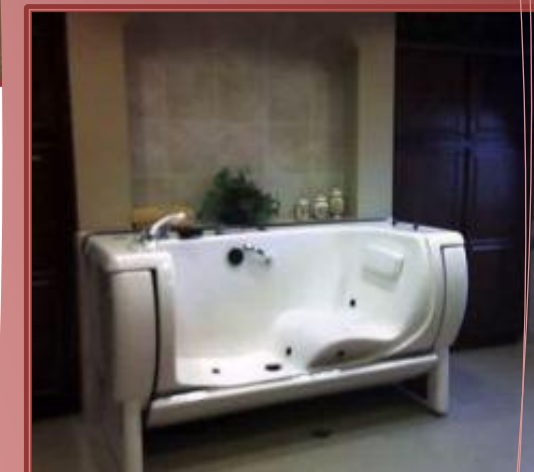
